Chronilus considers themselves to be a celtic world-beat band. They mix many different influences and styles to create a unique sound. Harps, keyboard, viola, guitar and powerful harmonizing vocals combine to form their enchanting music.

Chronilus has been on the WUPR Pagan Music Countdown with "The Wild In Me", "Heave Home" and their cover version of Gaia Consort's "The Rede (An' It Harm None)". Also the band's first recording effort, an EP titled "Prologue", helped them reach the #1 Celtic Band in Seattle and #1 on the World chart at ReverbNation.

On their latest album, "Threshold", the band recorded great cover versions of songs by Loreena McKennitt, Blackmore's Night and Gaia Consort. The cover songs only compliment the original material Chronilus

has produced. With songs off this album like "Gifts of the Fairies", "Ecstasy", "The Wild Hunt" and "Byker Hill" ... fans of the band are hooked on Chronilus and eagerly await their next release.
